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ORDER

Department of Tribal Welfare has, proposed to start, the Institutions of Excellence (Junior Colleges) by Department of Tribal Welfare, under the guidance of Sri Ch. Ramayya, noted-educationist to provide necessary academic environment and inputs to Intermediate S.T students to enable them to compete successfully for admissions into All India Level Exams such as IIT, NIT, IIT, Medical Colleges, EAMCET etc.

2. Government after careful consideration hereby sanction three Institutions of Excellence for providing specialized coaching to meritorious S.T students in Districts of Warangal, Chittoor & Visakhapatnam, from the academic year 2005-06.

3. 1) The three Institutions of excellence will be started from the academic year 2005-06 at Warangal, Srikalahasti (Chittoor District) and Vizakhapatnam, each catering to the S.T students from the catchment Districts mentioned below:-

2.	Chittoor (Srikalahasti)	Srisaillam	Kurnool, Guntur, Prakasham, Nellore, Chittoor, Kadapa, Anantapur
3.	Visakhapatnam	Padaru	Srikakulam, Vizianagram, Visakhapatnam, East Godavari, West Godavari & Krishna.

ii) Initially the (3) Institutions (Junior Colleges) will be located in the same Institutions where English Medium Schools had been established in the year 2002

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iii) Each School with English Medium of Instruction will first admit ST students who have secured more than 90% marks in the final SSC exam. Balance seats left if any will be filled through a test selection of the best students through a test for admission in these Institutions for academic year 2005-06 for Inter 1st & 2nd year and for Inter 1st year from next year onwards.

iv) These Institutions will be co-education and have MPC and Bi.pc groups, with each Section having 40 students. The sanctioned strength of each Junior College shall be (160) students.

v) In each Junior College, of 20% of the seats shall be filled from PTG groups and minimum of 20% shall be girls. The remaining seats shall be apportioned in proportion to the population of various tribal groups from each district (comprising the catchment area of the institutions).

4. Incentives subject to periodic review, shall be given to the teachers selected as follows:

i) The incentive shall be given to the Principal and Teachers @ Rs. 2500/- per month and Rs. 2000/- per month respectively as they have to handle additional work load by way of assignment, correction/valuation and extra classes.

ii) Additional Incentives: In order to motivate the teachers to strive for excellence, the following additional incentives shall be apportioned among Principal and Teaching staff including non-teaching staff as per a formula to be worked out by a Committee headed by Principal Secretary, Tribal Welfare, Commissioner, Tribal Welfare with Joint Secretary, Gurukulam as Member Convener in consultation with concerned.

iii) An amount of Rs.20000/- will be provided as incentive to the non-teaching staff to be apportioned by above mentioned committee on achieving of results as stipulated in reference 1st cited and / or as above at 4, ii)

5. The transfer rules will not apply to the teachers deputed / selected to these schools.

6. The children of the teachers selected will be permitted to attend the classes only, subject to obtaining a overall minimum level of 50% performance in their qualifying class

7. The selected teachers shall have to work with total commitment and dedication. Continuation of deputation shall be based strictly on performance.

8. Any other teacher Junior College of Gurukulam will also be entitled to the incentives as at para 4(i) to 4(iii) if they achieve the same results as at para 4(ii) in any year.
