Amendments to the minimum qualifications for recruitment of teachers in  
TSWR Schools

- The Committee has recommended 5% of marks for SC/ST/BC/ Differently abled candidates for Train Graduate Teacher cadre as per G.O.Ms.No.36 issued by the School Education Department dt.22.12.2015 regarding the qualifications required for TSTET Paper II (Classes VI to VIII). Regarding remaining posts the committee has stated that *“Regarding the minimum aggregate marks for SC/ST candidates there is no such stipulation in NCTE Regulations and the Tribal Welfare Department, Social Welfare Department, BC Welfare Department, Minority Welfare Department may take a view at their level accordingly”*.
- In view of the above, it is proposed to extend the same relaxation of 5% of marks for SC/ST/BC/ Differently abled candidates to all the remaining cadres also so as to maintain uniformity.
- The Committee has not recommended the qualifications for the posts of Principal, Art Teachers, Craft Teachers, Music Teachers, Librarians, Staff Nurse & ANM posts.
- Therefore, the existing qualifications for the above posts have been proposed with certain changes.

It was discussed and clarified that qualification for Mathematics PGT is a PG Degree in "Mathematics and Computer Science". It was by oversight noted as "Computer Science". The change is edorsed by Secretary SWREIS, TWREIS, Secretary MJPTBCWREIS, Secretary TREIS agreed but requested time to send the correction after seeking approval and special CS Education.

**3. PET-Eligibility of PH candidates - Regarding:**

As per G.O. Ms. No. 91, School Education (PE.Ser.II) Department Dt: 03/11/2012 (para 3f of Annexure I) Physically Challenged Quota should not be extended for Physical Education Teacher posts. Hence necessary changes must be made in the vacancy position of 100 cycle. All the Secretaries of Welfare Societies are requested to resend the Indents for PET & PD posts.

It is yet to be clarified whether PET or Skill Test has to be conducted. If yes, Components of Skill Test or PET has to be specified.

**4. CRAFT TEACHERS – Regarding:**

In the Amended Common Qualification. Commercial Garment Technology and Fashion and Garment making (F&GM) are included without mentioning Issuing Authority It was clarified that the latest copy of unified rules has carried the correction and shown Board of Intermediate Education as the certifying Authority. It was also informed by Sri. Vishweshwar Rao B.I.E, that CGT was earlier called "CGDM". This may also be considered as requisite qualification for Craft Teacher.

As per Rule-22 of State and Subordinate Service Rules, as amended in G.O.Ms.no.310 General Administration (Ser-D) Department dated: 19.07.2005 the roster points at S.No.13<sup>th</sup> and 37<sup>th</sup> out of 100 vacancies shall be reserved for Ex-servicemen. Out of 13<sup>th</sup> and 37<sup>th</sup> roster points, one of the two points for women can be given and if women candidates are not available, both the points with men shall be considered. However,


wherever the special or Ad-hoc rules provide that there shall be no reservation for Ex-servicemen or if a qualified and suitable candidate is not available for Ex-servicemen, the turn allotted to Ex-servicemen shall be deemed to be allotted to open competition.


