Gurukulam- Hyderabad- KGBV- Implementation of Revised Sub:- Guidelines received from RVM (SSA) - Certain instructions issued - Reg.

Ref:- Memo Rc.No. 11538/SSA/20011-1, dt: 23.06.2011 of the State Project Director, RVM (SSA), AP, Hyderabad.

While enclosing a copy of the reference cited, the following instructions were issued for smooth functioning of KGBVs under the control of Gurukulam for the year 2011-12.

- 1. To follow the revised guidelines issued by RVM (SSA) scrupulously and establish Gurukulam atmosphere in KGBVs.
- 2. RVM has taken a decision to enhance the student strength from the existing 120/170 to 200, hence you are requested to ensure that 200 children are enrolled in all KGBVs from Class VI to X for the year 2011-12 in both model I and model II schools.
- 3. The list of eligible students will be furnished by PO, RVM. After exhausting all seats with ST girls, the balance if any can be filled with other girls from BPL families and no seat shall be kept vacant.
- 4. The staffing pattern prescribed by the RVM shall be strictly observed.
- 5. To make recruitment of teaching (CRTs) and Non-Teaching staff through the committee constituted under the Chairmanship of Project Officer in ITDA areas and Dist. Collector in Non-ITDA areas.
- 6. The eligibility of CRT is Graduation with professional qualification B.Ed. or its equivalent.

- 7. RVM has also enhanced the remuneration to the Teachers and Non Teaching staff.
- 8. Suitable special officers shall be selected from regular Government teachers only. Retired teachers can be considered only as a stopgap arrangement.
- 9. The service contracts shall be terminated every year on the last working day of the KGBV. A fresh contract shall be entered in the next academic year on the re-opening day of the KGBVs based on the performance of the teacher.
- 10. The balanced Diet(menu) shall be decided by Gurukulam and breakfast must be a non-rice item and Project Officer in ITDAs and Addl. Joint Collector shall monitor for its implementation.
- 11. While appointing Vocational /Art/ Drawing Teachers, the Vocational Course shall be identified by utilising the locally available raw material, preparation of sanitary napkins and local marketing facilities.
- 12. Teachers and girls are to be trained in making of sanitary napkins in coordination with PO, RVM.
- 13. Tenders shall be finalised for the items such as Vegetables, Milk provisions, eggs, fruits, Sweets and firewood etc. The Project Officer of ITDAs and Joint Collector of Non-ITDAs shall take special interest to adopt Gas system instead of firewood in hostels to economise the expenditure.
- 14. To procure infrastructural items such as furniture, Utensils, Games equipment, Trunk Boxes, Plates & Glasses, shoes, socks etc., through DPC as per norms prescribed by RVM (SSA).
- 15. To pay special attention to conduct special intensive coaching to the X class students during Pongal holidays to enable the children to score good marks.
- 16. To monitor the functioning of KGBVs and provide professional support as is being done in case of Residential schools.
